

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **How do I apply for the bursary?**

The bursary application form is to be completed and submitted at the same time as you complete the Faculty of Clinical Informatics application form. Both forms can be found [here](#).

## **How will the bursary be applied?**

The Shuri Network will liaise directly with the Faculty of Clinical Informatics in order to cover the cost of one year's annual membership for the successful applicants. You will be informed of whether you have been granted a bursary at the time you are informed of the outcome of the Faculty of Clinical Informatics' application as it is at this stage that FCI requires fee payment.

## **What levels of Faculty membership are covered?**

Bursaries can be given for either FCI Associate or Member. If you are accepted as an associate or member, but not granted a Shuri bursary, and still want to join the Faculty, you will need to pay the annual fee:

Associate: £51

Member: £102

Student £10

## **When is the application deadline?**

The bursary application deadline is the same as the deadline for the Faculty of Clinical Informatics' application which is midnight on 12th September 2021.

## **When will I be notified of the decision?**

You will be notified of the outcome of the bursary application at the same time as you are informed of the outcome of your Faculty of Clinical Informatics' application.

## **If I am unsuccessful, will I be told why?**

General feedback will be provided to any unsuccessful applicants and more specific detail will depend on the number that have applied and the corresponding capacity of the Shuri Network.
